



How To Make Binoculars

Perfect for bird watching, or spotting land ahoy!

You Will Need

2 empty toilet rolls (or an empty kitchen roll to make a telescope instead)
wool
scissors
tape
felt pens

Instructions

1. Use your felt pens to decorate the two toilet roll tubes.
2. Take the tubes and place them next to each other on a table. Carefully tape around the tubes so that they are attached to each other. Put two lots of tape around them, so that they are nice and secure.
3. With the scissors, carefully make two holes - one on each side - at one end of the tubes (an adult may need to do this bit).
4. Cut a length of wool and attach the ends, with a knot, through the holes you have just made in your binoculars. This is a carrying strap to put over your head.
5. Use your binoculars outside to see how many different birds you can spot.
